Kent County and Grand Rapids clothing closets.

Income qualified families in Kent County Michigan can turn to clothing closets, churches, thrift stores and other charities to receive free or low cost clothing and other household supplies. If your income is low enough, or if you are faced with a crisis, then the items may be provided for free. Otherwise many of the thrift stores and non-profits in Kent County will request a minimal fee or donation.

What an individual will find at these centers will vary. It often depends on donations and the season in question. In general, some of the more common items can include shoes, school backpacks, toys and gifts for Christmas, winter coats, boots, and other standard clothing. The demand for assistance in Kent County is fairly high and resources are limited. Conditions may need to be met by applicants.
